Dorothea Mackellar, an Australia poet, composed a poem about Australia called: My Country. One stanza is better known than the rest.

I love a sunburnt country, A land of sweeping plains, Of ragged mountain ranges, Of droughts and flooding rains. I love her far horizons, I love her jewel-sea, Her beauty and her terror -The wide brown land for me!

Four members of the Executive Committee of the OMCC, Yvonne, Margaret, Peter and myself, live in Queensland, and in, or very close to Brisbane, the state capital and third largest city in Australia.

Recently our city and state have been in the grip of massive floods and now face the task of burying the dead, searching for people swept away and cleaning mud-drenched homes and rebuilding others damaged or destroyed.

From the ark of Noah, the Moses led passage through the Red Sea to the John the Baptist immersion of Jesus in the Jordan, deliverance from floods or deliverance through water is part of salvation history. Water is essential for life but it can also bring death.
