Dear Friends in Christ,

It has made me acutely aware that we can be effective in our environments , wherever they may be, by witnessing always to the love of God. He gives us paths to follow, people to guide, but in the end it is by our personal acceptance of these tools that we are most effective.

Through the charismatic inspiration of the Holy Spirit, received by one lay man, who sharing it with others, brought about the birth of Cursillos in Christianity, we have been given a wonderful gift to guide us- show the love of God to each person through friendship.
