SEED

This month of january, I wish to remind the whole family cursillista, the important gift of God which is the unity in Communion in the same spirit of humility and service.

In a world increasingly secularised and indifferent to God, if not hostile, results increasingly absurd and meaningless the lack of unity among Christ's followers. The division among Christians is a serious antitestimony. Indeed, how can the non-believers accept the proclamation of the Gospel, if the Christians, even when referring to the same Christ, are at odds among themselves? The communion and unity among Christ's disciples is a particularly important condition for greater credibility and effectiveness of their testimony.

The commitment of Christian Unity is not only for some, or an ancillary activity of the Church. Each one is called to contribute, above all through prayer. This reflection regard to the proposal that the month of January shows to all Christians: the ecumenical dimension that Christianity takes on your concern of conversion and maturing in Faith and Charity, hoping that the sweet Lord help us in every effort undertaken for the unity of Christians.

Also the MCC accept this call and performs in various countries of the world a experience of "three ecumenical days", in which the "kerygmatic" ad is shared by several participating Churches, in absolute respect for the specificities and the discipline of each confession present.

For all of us, the eighth days of pray for Christian Unity are, each year, a unique opportunity to bring the various Christian churches to pray together for the same intention: that God, in his goodness, should illuminate the churches with the gift of his spirit, so that they are Christians.

The modern ecumenical movement has its origins in the late 19th century and the early 20th century. In 1908, two Ministers of the Anglican Church, S. Jones and P. Wattson, were inspired to write a regular prayer for Christian Unity: thus arose the eighth days of pray.

Among Catholics, the forerunner of the ecumenical movement was Fr. Paul Couturier, a French Jesuit, the great booster of the eighth days of pray for Christian Unity.

We will respond with our unit to the question posed by Paul of Tarsus to the Corinth Church: «Is Christ divided?» (1 Cor. 1, 13).
