SEED

February began with the feast of the Presentation of Jesus at the Temple by Mary and Joseph. Then the 'Light of Nations' was recognized and praised by Simeon and Ana de Phanuel, representatives of the "Rest of Israel" who remained faithful to the intentions of God about the coming of the Saviour of the world.

In celebration of this feast, we used the symbolism of light. Thus, candles were blessed and lit, in an allusion to our membership and participation in Christ, «light of the world»; the One who became man for us and suffered, was crucified and buried; resurrected on the third day.

On this feast of light, always in a reference of the Easter Vigil, at which performs a very evocative rite: after blessed the "new fire", the Paschal Candle, from where we can give light to all men until the Church is completely flooded with light.

The Church that was previously dipped in darkness, now became illuminated... This rite represents excellently how spreads the light of the risen Christ, the Faith.

Jesus came into the world to spread the Gospel to all of mankind. To achieve this end, He didn't write any book as normally do the men who want to propagate a message: write a book with their ideas and then try to spread it. He, who created the man, knows very well our heart and know that what changes our life are not the words or arguments, but the testimonies and examples of happiness and liberation. Therefore, for proceed to proclaim the Gospel, Jesus sent witnesses. He called Peter, John, James and the other Apostles and sent them as witnesses in order to take Him to the world. The experience of finding ourselves with a witness of Christ is very special. Is the same like to find what's in the darkness of our lives, what we wanted, what we knew in advance, but we weren't able to express. That's what happened to Timothy, when he met Paulo, Polycarp or John. This is what experiment all that met themselves with the new Apostles of the 21st century. The same happen with us, in the joy of our Cursillos: evangelized converted into evangelizers; those who met with the witnesses of Christ, are now those who are with them.

In fact, the rite of light with that initiates the Easter Vigil and that we remember the feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple in Jerusalem, in this month of February, represents the way how the light of Christ can be transmit from person to person, witness the witness: «So let your light shine before men, that they may see your Good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven». (Mt. 5, 15)
