## RECOGNITION

Eduardo Bonnín, one of the founders of Cursillos, has now a street in Palma with his name.

The Mayor of Palma, through its Decree number 6140 of April 10, 2014, decided to assign the name "Pasaje de Eduardo Bonnín" to a narrow street next to the Church of the Capuchins in Palma (where is his grave ), between the Capuchin Street and the "Piazza Condado del Rosseló".

On the May 9<sup>th</sup> was celebrated a mass in his memory in the Church of the Capuchins in Palma, chaired by the Bishop of Mallorca, Mons. Javier Salinas.

After the mass take place the institutional act of placing the nameplate.

Is unusual a community pay tribute to someone by the simple fact of being a Christian, especially someone who devoted his entire life trying to be like he always said, a "Christian's Apprentice".



Eduardo Bonnín, over the years, try to transmit to everybody, particularly the most far from God and the Church, "the best new that is the love of God, through Friendship, and addressed to the best of each, being a Person".

These were the three pillars of his thought: Christ, Person and Friendship!

A street, maybe the smallest of Palm, but very big in meaning as it is situated where once was the prison yard where Eduardo so often shared his friendship with the prisoners.
