

To perform this proposal, we developed several blocks to work on with three clear lines of action:

 - The third edition of Fundamental Ideas.

- Third: Review and promote the current projects, such as the support of the "African Project" and the development of new actions that leads us to a more active presence of MCC in Europe, trying to take MCC to new countries (France, Poland) y strengthening its performance in those where it is already present.

SOME THOUGHTS TO KEEP IN MIND

At the GECC meeting held last November in Toledo, we had the opportunity to reflect, to share, to communicate, but also to pray together through the Word of God and the Eucharist. I would like to share with you some memories that come to my mind.

- 1. MCC now days. We have consolidated the importance and need of MCC at this moment of the new evangelization in each of our countries. And we have renewed our thrilled love in our service for the MCC, deciding to live, encourage and build up communion among all of us, as that is the way the people will believe in our evangelization mission, having a common reference, the new Fundamental Ideas. We have received from the Church a unique heritage that is Cursillos and they trust in us to give abundant fruit. It is our responsibility now to carry it on.
- 2. A spirit full of joy. Our job and meditation about what are the essentials in our MCC, which is the joyful proclamation of the Kerygma, has to be approached with joy. Our Pope Francis reminds this to us in the E.G when he says "this must be the centre of the evangelizing action... because it is the main announcement, the one we always have to listen to and always must announce again". It is an encouragement and statement as if it has been said to our Movement, which must awaken our enthusiasm to strengthen our position in the essentials of our charisma and our being as MCC, which is the first announcement, as the Pope keeps saying: "nothing is as solid, deep, secure, dense and wise as this announcement" (pages 164 and 165). Enthusiasm because this evangelizing action is what the Church of today asks our Movement to do.
- 3. In communion. The Pope Francis in the E. G. emphasizes the importance of having a spirit of communion, charity and fraternity, if we truly want to live as evangelizers in the Church, "within the people of God and in the different communities, ihow many wars!, he says, to the Christians of all the communities of the world, I would specially like to ask you for a testimony of fraternal communion that becomes attractive, radiant, that all admire you how you take care of each other..., how you encourage and accompanied one another...let's ask the Lord to make us understand the law of love" (pages 98-1101).



4. With responsibility. The MCC is a great heritage we have received and as it has been given to us as a gift of God. We are not the owners of Cursillos, it's not our property. We have been entrusted to use it the best we can, giving the best of it to the Church, so it is useful for the new

Fundamental Ideas - Conclusions of some of the chapters

As in the previous Newsletter, We publish the conclusions of the fifth and sixth chapter of the new Fundamental Ideas.

CHAPTER 5 THE STRATEGY OF THE CM CONCLUSION

A. Understanding the strategy to understand the method

The CM is constituted as an ecclesial movement from its charism and from its shared mentality which focuses on a particular purpose by means of a specific method. In order to properly develop such action it is necessary to have a suitable strategy which should be understood and known (its basic options and development).

B. Knowing the strategy to properly apply the method

The application of the method is always reviewed and carried out from the basic assumptions of the strategy. Without a global vision of the purpose and the basic strategic plan of the CM, the application of the method could be distorted.

CHAPTER 6 THE METHOD OF THE CM CONCLUSION

A. The method of the CM enables effective evangelizing action

The method of the CM, which is an essential element of its identity, a function of the life of the Movement, enables the Movement to perform fruitful and effective action appropriately.

D. The method needs to be applied appropriately.

Those that are leaders in the CM, by being so, need to know, appreciate and respect the method properly to be able to apply it in the most appropriate manner to the purpose of the Movement.
