News from Canada

CONFERENCE OF CANADIAN CATHOLIC CURSILLOS

The focus of Canada is, and has been, help our *cursillistas* to get to a deeper understanding of the mentality, method and purpose of Cursillo Movement.

Since 1992, the CCCC has been back to the original charism of Cursillo in Christianity and is therefore in close contact with the Majorcan leadership based on the reality that Mallorca is the birthplace of Cursillos and where has remained faithful to the charism received by Eduardo Bonnín. For this purpose, the CCCC has published the book by Eduardo "*Christian's apprentice*" and the book "*History and memory*" by Francisco Forteza.

We continue to work on the translation of the writings of Edward and plans are underway to receive the collaboration of the leaders of the United States to accelerate the work.

In our annual Canadian National Conferences, we have encouraged the study of the founding charism.

In Sydney, , Nova Scotia, the 2013 Conference focused on three conferences of Mallorca, the *"Conversaciones de Cala Figuera"*, and the presentations were developed to clarify the message and the method of *Cursillos*, especially "Christianity in action", the cornerstone of the method,.

CONCLUSION

A. Grace as the principle and foundation of Precursillo.

The CM is the work of God and His grace is absolutely necessary in all its activities. Therefore, communion with God through prayer, and the sacraments, will mark every moment of the Precursillo.

B. The community as a support.

The Precursillo, besides being based on the grace of God, is also a human work, supported and enlivened by the community.

- A community that sends the team to the mission
- A community that prays for each Cursillo
- A community with a strong sense of Church.

The community which supports the Precursillo with its prayer is:

- The community of the School of Leaders and the Secretariat.
- The entire community of the CM (Group Reunions and Ultreyas).
- The ecclesial community, because the CM is Church, and builds up the Church in the world.

CONCLUSION

A. The Cursillo is a gift

The Cursillo is a "wonderful gift of God" which makes possible the greatest experience a person can live: to meet the Lord, discover and live the essence of being a Christian and project a new life.

B. With different elements

This is achieved firstly by the grace of God, secondly by the free choice of the person and, finally, by a methodological technique, developed by the team of leaders.

C. One sole purpose

All the various elements of the method of the Cursillo have the same purpose: to be channels of Grace, and the means by which the Holy Spirit can reach people.

D. Some requirements

For the Cursillo to be what it can be, it is necessary to have:

- A thorough and accurate knowledge, which clearly recognizes what is essential, important and optional in the Cursillo.
- Respect, humility and sense of wonder for what the Cursillo can be in the lives of people.
- An attitude of willingness and service to do whatever is necessary to actually fulfil the purpose of the Cursillo.
